

# Baldwin Prep School High School Lunch Privilege

Students in High School have the opportunity to eat out for lunch under the agreement that:

- They have A's and B's, and no more than one C in their classes.
- They have parent's permission to leave campus.
- They have parent's permission to drive with other students.
- They must have good conduct in class.
- They have to be back by the end of their lunch & recess period.

Students that have parent permission will be given a Lunch Pass Card and lanyard that they need to show in order to leave campus. The weekly Google Doc will be monitored. Should a student have privileges suspended, due to grades or conduct, their Lunch Pass Card will be confiscated and returned once privileges are reinstated. (Minimum two weeks)

**If a student leaves campus while privileges are suspended, they will be suspended out of school for two days.**

Please be aware that allowing students to leave school is allowing them to be unsupervised.
